The competition is organised to encourage riders and/or horses who have not been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in dressage or show jumping classes. Other combinations will be welcome to ride, HC, in the classes for which they are ineligible. In the spirit of the competition, professional riders are welcome but requested to ride HC.

General instruction sessions consist of some flatwork and, time permitting, some optional gridwork or a small course of jumps at the end. Each session will last 1½ hours.

Cross Country Instruction Body protectors are compulsory. The sessions will last for 2 hours.

Directions to Tweseldown Take M3 to Junction 5 (Hook). Turn right heading towards Farnham (A287). Second left at roundabout (still Farnham) and second left again at next one (still towards Farnham). Keep going along the A287 (along long straight and then up long, long hill) until you reach another roundabout; turn left (B3013) down long hill until you enter Church Crookham. First right (The Tweseldown Pub) into Bourley Road.

Directions to Boomerang

- From M4 - Junction 14 head north on A338 towards Wantage.
- After 300 yards turn left towards Lambourn on the B4000
- Go past The Hare pub on your left (approx. 4.5 miles)
- At the next cross roads turn left
- Follow this road straight over the motorway
- Carry straight on, over a sharp left turn onto a single track road
- Follow road sharply to the right and take the next left, sign posted for Raffin Stud
- Continue past Raffin Stud through dog leg in road
- Lorry Park can be found on the left (look for gap in high hedge, opposite big black barn)

Inter Club Team & Individual Competitions for Seniors & Juniors

BVRC is one of twenty designated to British Riding Clubs Area 17. Geographically the area covers the central south of England, stretching from Petersfield in the East to Blandford and Purbeck in the West & includes the Isle of Wight. Our club sits on the northern edge of the area.

Each year inter club team competitions are organised in Show Jumping, Horse Trials and Dressage & Dressage to Music. The winning teams and individuals from these competitions and from all other Areas around Great Britain go forward to BRC National Riding Club Championships at the end of the summer.

The Horse Trials Championships is held at Aston le Walls, Nr Banbury between 6th & 8th August. The Novice Championships becomes a 2 day event, including roads & tracks & steeplechase, and the Intermediate, like Open Championships, is a full 3 day event.

The Championships for all Dressage & Show Jumping will be returning to the Lincolnshire Showground on 11th & 12th September.

Dressage to Music Championships will be held at Aintree International Equestrian Centre, Liverpool on 9th & 10th October.

Due the reclassification of juniors, anyone under 18 years old on 1st January of the current year is eligible to represent BVRC as a junior at BRC Area competitions. The majority of competitions listed below have junior sections, although there may be some variation in jumping heights and dressage tests.

Teams comprise four members, with the best three scores accrued to give the team total.

Please remember that the horse must have valid up to date Flu Vaccination Certificate / Passport, which must comply in every respect to the rules shown below.

There are some restrictions in the eligibility of horses and riders for the various competitions. If you wish to be considered for a place in any of the competitions, please fill in and return the attached team forms to Susie Pool, together with two photocopies of the horse's Flu vacc certificate / Passport (one copy for each competition for which you would like to be considered + one extra for Susie).

Please make sure you copy every section (front, back & middle) of the certificate – including the name & address of the owner, the horse's name, silhouette, markings & every single vaccinations entry.

The team application forms give details of the latest date for them to be returned.

ONCE YOU HAVE RETURNED YOUR FORM PLEASE LET SUSIE KNOW IMMEDIATELY IF YOU ARE NO LONGER AVAILABLE. The team competitions cost the club a lot of money, which we do not want to waste.

The team selection policy is as follows:

On the basis of the response to the team forms, a decision is made about how many teams to enter. Details of how many teams and individuals we want to enter are sent, **with an entry fee**, to British Riding Clubs (3-4 weeks before the competition).

Entries detailing who is in which team is sent to the Area Competition Organiser (**with another entry fee**) about 7-10 days before the competition is held.

Team members are asked to make a contribution towards entry fees to area qualifying competitions. In the last couple of years, team costs have been running at around £2500-£3000, the price of being successful & attending BRC National Championships. Although in these terms a contribution to area competitions is a drop in the ocean, it will provide 30-50% of the area expenditure. We are requesting £10 for each team / individual place for Dressage, £15 for each team / individual place for Show Jumping & £20 for each team / individual place for Horse Trials.

The money is to be enclosed with the application form. A refund will only be made in the event of injury / illness to horse or rider which prevents them from participating in the competition.

The club pays all entry fees to Championships.

Selection for team places is based on performance at club competitions or other known events.

It is normally the case that, subject to eligibility, anyone keen to take part will be offered the opportunity to ride for the club.

The area competitions are great events giving us the opportunity to meet and compete against other clubs in the area and participate in a team environment. We want to encourage any one interested to have a go, but in the event of teams or individuals qualifying for National Championships, we need to know in advance if you are prepared to go the Championships.

There may be many reasons why you can't or don't want to attend the Championships. It will not stop us asking you to represent the club, but it may just affect who goes in which team.

Anyone applying for team places will be notified if their application has been successful.

Even if you stated on your membership application that you were interested in teams, please fill in and return the team application forms.

PLEASE READ THE FLU VACC RULES SHOWN BELOW AND MAKE SURE YOUR HORSE'S Certificate COMPLIES WITH THE RULES IN EVERY RESPECT.

BRC equine influenza rules are based on the British Horseracing Authority Rules (BHA formerly The Jockey Club Rules).

Susie will check all certificates submitted to her but please remember that it is your responsibility to ensure your horse has a valid certificate that fully complies with the BHA Rules in all respects.

The certificate will have to be presented at all BRC Official Competitions.

Equine Influenza - Valid Certificates – Vaccination procedures

*Each horse must have a valid vaccination certificate, which undeniably relates to that horse, completed, **signed and stamped** on each relevant line by a veterinary surgeon, who is not the owner of the animal.*

It must state that the horse has received the appropriate course of injections against Equine Influenza as follows:

Primary Vaccination: *Two injections, the 2nd between 21 days and 92 days after the 1st.*

First Booster: *An injection between 150 days and 215 days after 2nd primary injection.*

Annual Booster *An injection not more than 1 year after the preceding injection.*

Only the first two injections need to have been given for the horse to compete.

*None of the vaccinations may be given within the **preceding 7 days**, including the day of the competition or entry into competition stables.*

Annual Boosters may be given on the same date each year, but this is not recommended.

Horses foaled before 1st January 1980 need not have had the first booster injection (no less 150 days and no more than 215 days) after the second injection of the primary vaccination – but must have had an annual booster (given within 12 months) thereafter.

Note: Where Passports are used as the flu' vaccination record, the horse description must be verified by a vet or authorised member of a breed society.

If the passport does not contain the full vaccination history then, to comply with rule above, the flu vaccination certificate must also accompany the pony/horse to all BRC Qualifiers and Championships.

Checking of certificates at BRC competitions is very stringent and the BRC Rulebook says the following:

Full vaccination histories and drawings will be checked at all Area Qualifiers and at all Championships before the pony or horse is allowed to compete, and anyone with an invalid certificate will not be permitted to compete. Any pony/horse that is in a team competition that is disqualified at an Area Qualifier cannot be replaced, the team will have to continue as a team of three, or if already a team of three, will have to compete as individuals only, if there is an individual competition.

Any pony/horse disqualified at an Area Qualifier under this rule will be reported to the BRC Office. If that team qualifies for a Championship then the disqualified pony/horse cannot be replaced with a reserve for that Championship and the team must remain a team of three.

It is worth remembering

There is now a legal requirement for a valid passport to accompany the horse when traveling to any competition.

Winter Show Jumping – Castle Farm, Over Wallop, 21 March 2010

The competition day was an enjoyable one and it was great to have a bunch of friendly faces helping out, putting anxious competitors at ease. Without willing volunteers (either setting up on Saturday or on the day itself) we just couldn't host such competitions and I hope that most of the helpers have an opportunity to have their efforts reciprocated. We were very lucky to benefit from a pleasant gap in the wet weather which made it nice for us all and brought out some much needed late entries. As a result my fears about not covering our costs were unfounded and we were able to make a small contribution to Club funds.

My special thanks go to our worthy arena parties, Stuart Bruce (who also co-judged and commentated in the afternoon), Tom Wheeler and Charlie Cooper who are not riders and came to help out of sheer goodwill (with maybe some maternal coercion in some cases!). Their efforts made changing the courses a much quicker and slicker operation and my back is very thankful for the help!

Thankfully everyone did stay safe, which made my life much easier. Everyone elected to get up early and not take overnight stabling. It made it a very long day but everyone did really well. Frances and Parsnip set the standard by jumping clear in the first round and the other 3 duly followed suit. What a great start! We were one of only 4 teams out of 27 to do so. As it is the best 3 scores to count there were 9 teams on zero penalties after the first round. It was a very good place to be but so much can change in the 2nd round. This was supposed to be 2'9" but it seems that the rule book tends to be thrown out of the window at Championships and some of the fences were definitely bigger (as will be the case under the 2010 rules). Parsnip again set the pace with a nippy clear round and Mandy and Dublin also did a similarly quick clear round. Times count in this round in the event of equal penalties for lower places however I wanted the team to focus on going clear. Sadly Jeebs and Fen had a difference of opinion about how to jump the last fence; Jeebs decided to put a short one in and took the front pole off the oxer. All the pressure was then on Ruth and Joey to jump clear to take us into the jump-off as Taunton RC, the 2nd team to go, was already on a score of zero. For the first time in ages Joey didn't manage to jump clear, he also took a rail off an oxer at fence 7, having cleared the bogey fences that many combinations were taking down. However, they held it together for the rest of the course and maintained the team on 4 penalties. Shortly after Ruth's round, Cambridge RC's last rider jumped clear forcing a jump-off, which they subsequently won. East Midlands RC finished 3rd, probably ruing the 2 time penalties accrued in the 2nd round. Three teams finished on 4 faults and on count-back of the 2nd round times we came 5th. A really great result as there is often so little in it. Very well done everyone and a real credit to Bourne Valley Riding Club.
