We must start with a grateful thanks to Sandra Groves and the scoring team of Celia Scott, Rebecca Olpin, Frances Hall and Alex and Jenna Plank. Moreton is a bit of a trek not to ride (why do I keep doing it?!) and without their help we would not have been allowed to compete. Organising the teams turned out to be a total nightmare! We had entered a Novice Team and 2 individuals, an Intermediate Team and an Open Team. We had just filled the 2 "senior" teams when 3 Novices dropped out through lameness with less than a week to go. Thank goodness for email! Within 48 hours the places were filled and I even had a spare!! Just as well as another dropped out and he spare was called in. Checking the flu vacs and sending copies to the organiser were another matter though and I didn't manage to get them all checked before the competition. One was found to be out of date but thankfully it was one of the individuals and Peter Buist allowed her to compete HC (as there were open competitions anyway).

Laura Young was entered as our token Junior in the Intermediate class. It was a nail-biting finish but she certainly set the standard for the Seniors by winning her Class and qualifying for the Championships, despite 2 fences down in the Show Jumping – her dressage score was **that** good. An excellent start to the event. Even though the show jumping was on a surface, Louise's Roman Rhythm decided that it was time to hang up his boots and call it a day – those show jumps were very scary for someone who's been there and done it all before! I think that he saw me there and realised if he did well he might have to go to those Championships again and do a 2 or 3 day event! The other Novices who went forward to the XC jumped clear with Mandy and Alex finishing on their dressage scores and achieving individual 3rd and 4th places in their arenas respectively. The team came a creditable 3rd but sadly no qualifiers for the Championships.

A little way into the day I realised that we had the only teams entered for the Intermediate and Open competitions; provided 3 in each completed we would qualify. They did much better than that and all 8 completed although Cath, Harriet, Marion picked up jumping penalties on the XC. Minette got round the XC without time penalties but had had an unusual 2 down in the show jumping. Michelle was our highest placed individually (2nd) with only 0.4 time penalties having also jumped clear chow jumping. In the Open, Laura and Gemma were also placed individually.

Well done everyone – get set for a 3 Day Event at the Championships!! Stay safe.

BVRC representatives were thin on the ground for the Area Show Jumping this year. The prolonged period of dry weather and hard ground had taken its toll. What we lacked in quantity we more than made up for in quality. Emma, Alex and Kim did us proud. Between them they jumped ten rounds and finished the day with nine clears and an overall total of just four faults. Emma started the day by winning the warm up class. This was followed up with the only double clear rounds in the Junior Intermediate, giving her victory without the need to jump off. Emma has qualified for the BRC Championships on 12th September and is off to Lincoln.

Alex started her campaign with a classy third place in the very competitive Style jumping. Proceeding to the Senior Intermediate jumping, she achieved one of only three double clear rounds to go forward to the jump off. A slight touch of one pole resulted in four faults and third place in the class. The winner and the only one clear in the jump off, was having a lucky day. Initially eliminated from the first round after jumping an extra fence, she was subsequently re-instated. It was deemed that the horse jumped an extra fence because it had been spooked by the arena party.

After jumping a double clear in the Novice competition, Kim faced a jump off against several small speed merchants. Unfortunately, Bailey at 16.3h, was not able to catch them and despite being clear again, remained unplaced. Kim, however, was delighted with Baileys unblemished record on his return to competition, after a long layoff. Well done to all three girls for their excellent performances and being a credit to BVRC.

The venue provided space for at least 6 level arenas, ample warm up and easy parking. In spite of the lack of rain, the going was very good. As the site was later to be used for activities for adults and children, they obviously made it a condition that the site had to be cleared after the event as I saw some noble members of Chilworth RC going round the warm up area with a wheelbarrow during the day! THANK YOU!

Overall it was a very good day, in spite of Sandra coming out and saying that Timmy didn't go very well and Lindsay saying that Deva was tense; they were both placed. I wish that I could do as well on a bad day! Kingsmill and Max did their usual accomplished tests and even though Lindsay's sheet was added up incorrectly and she was given a 4th place, the team won! Hoorah, another Championship qualification! We also entered a Riding Test Team, which we hoped might be quite strong, and they finished 2nd – if there had been one more team entered in the class they would also have qualified! At this point we are still awaiting confirmation that Emma and Kingsmill qualified as an individual.

Sadly the Open Team had to compete as a team of 3 as our last minute Elementary rider had to drop out at an even later minute! Alex Plank and Elle Treeka achieved a 6th and was the highest placed of the team. Tobleroan looked as if he had been stung just before going into the dressage arena and we wondered for a while if Jane would stay inside the boards, especially in the canter – apparently she thought so too! With Jane's quiet, tactful riding they succeeded in completing the test and part-way through Tobleroan did calm a little. Our individual riders didn't fair much better and none caught the judges' eyes that day.

Having been privileged to have the use of Max for Camp in April I persuaded Frances to have a go at the Pairs with me on her 2 grey Highland ponies. I designed the test and we practiced a few times the day before! We entered for fun, which it was, and expected to come last, which we didn't. We achieved a 4th out of 7 in spite of me allowing Max to canter in the Medium trot and trot in one of the canters!!
