Subscriptions

were due for renewal on 1st November. Well done to those of you who have already rejoined. Rates were increased to £25, for Riding Members, at last year's AGM, but remain at £12 for Non Riding Members. A reduced rate of £20 will apply for second and each subsequent member of the same household. BRC Insurance

As a Riding Club affiliated to the British Horse Society, BVRC carries a certain level of insurance cover. It has become apparent that clarification is needed about the insurance cover of individual club members. The policy offers third party personal liability insurance. Members will be insured whilst taking part in activities (riding or helping) organised by BVRC, another BHS affiliated Riding Club or British Riding Clubs office at Stoneleigh. Travel to and from activities is EXCLUDED. Members are NOT INSURED outside RC activities, e.g. hacking out independently. Rule Reminder

The club doesn't have too many rules, but just as a general reminder to keep everyone on the straight and narrow here are details of the ones that seem to cause most problems. BVRC membership is open to people 17 years old or older (with no upper age limit). 16 year olds may compete in competitions and attend any riding event as a member's guest, (with permission of the organiser) but BVRC does not allow under 16's to ride at their events. They do, however, welcome guests of any age at their socials.

Anyone riding at our events MUST wear correct approved headgear. The current standard is **at least to the recommended standards PAS015 or EN1384; hats prefixed SEI or ASTM are permissible (ASTM is not valid on its own, it must have the SEI prefix)**. Hats shall have a chin strap which has a non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Hats marked EN1384, PAS015 or prefixed ASTM or SEI are the minimum standard allowed. Hard Hats to specification PAS015 or ASTM F1163 are considered to offer greater protection than EN1384. Recommended hats should carry the quality assurance stamp of Kitemark or SEI. American standard SNELL E2001 and Australian or New Zealand standard SNZ 3838 1998 are also acceptable. Where a hat is of skullcap style, this must be worn with a silk. Such headgear shall be worn properly adjusted and fastened at all times when mounted.

PLEASE NOTE FROM 1st APRIL 2007 A HAT WITH A FIXED PEAK IS NOT PERMISSIBLE FOR CROSS COUNTRY.

Please be aware before you turn up that you bring the right hat with you to every single riding event & competition that we run.

Body protectors (Class 3 - Purple Label) shall be worn for any event involving cross-country jumping and are strongly recommended for show jumping.

Medical armbands (armbands issued by BE and BRC) are mandatory at Club One Day event and Hunter Trial competitions.

For safety reasons it is not permissible to wear jewellery or any items worn in facial or body piercings whilst competing.

Chaps or half-chaps may not be worn whilst competing either. Gaiters are permissible.

There is also a rule for BRC competitions and states '*long hair should be worn in a net or secured in such way as not to hang below the collar for safety reasons*'.

Otherwise there is no particular dress code, it is sufficient just to be "clean and tidy". Correct footwear (i.e. no Muckers) is a good idea.

'How your horse's teeth affect his performance' talk by Martin Walls, Equine Dental Technician, on Friday 8th February 2008, at the Red Lion, Clanville, Nr Weyhill 7-30pm for 8pm start.

Martin Walls has kindly agreed to come and give a very informative talk on Equine Dentistry with excellent photos, pictures and skulls to study. Martin trained at the Academy of Equine Dentist in Idaho, USA in 1998. As a result he is a certified Equine Dentist and also holds the British qualification of Equine Dental Technician. He has lectured at the British Equine Veterinary Association (BEVA) Conference in Glasgow and is due to return again next year. He also lectures at various colleges including Sparsholt. He is based between Winchester and Southampton and mainly covers the Hampshire area. He is recommended by Woodlands Veterinary Practice and Endell Veterinary Hospital as well as numerous other Practices and also receives referrals from the vets at the Liphook Equine Hospital.

BRC Area 17 Novice Indoor Show Jumping Qualifier on Saturday 1st March 2008 at Kingston Maurward EC, Nr Dorchester

Teams of four riders compete over two rounds, with jumps 80cm (2'6") in the first and 85cm (2'9") in the second round. The team total is made up from the best three scores in each round. The winning teams go forward to National Championships at Hartpury College EC on 5th / 6th April.

Horses with any BSJA winnings, BE points or BE Pre-Novice 1st – 6th placings are ineligible.

Sally Lewis has agreed to share chef d'equip duties with Susie Pool this year. If you are interested in being part of a team please fill in and return the attached form to Sally (07771 888036) by the Wednesday 30th January.

Please remember that you will need to have a fully up to date flu certificate (for your horse), and have paid your subscriptions.

Please Note: riders may only compete for one club in any competition year.

The team selection policy is as follows:

On the basis of the response of the team forms, a decision is made about how many teams to enter.

Selection for team places is based on performance at club competitions or other known events and willingness to go to the Championships if we are good enough to qualify.

It is normally the case that, subject to eligibility, anyone keen to take part will be offered a team place.

If you think you would like to have a go but are not sure then ring Sally (07771 888036) for a chat. Otherwise, even if you stated on your membership application that you were interested in teams, please fill in and return your form.

The club pays all Entry Fees to Area competitions.

It is expected that team members will enter the Area 17 Winter League Show Jumping on Saturday 23rd February at Sparsholt EC.

PLEASE READ THE VACCINATION RULES BELOW AND CHECK THAT YOUR HORSE'S CERTIFICATE COMPLIES IN EVERY RESPECT.

Equine Influenza - Valid Certificates – Vaccination procedures

*Each horse must have a valid vaccination certificate, which undeniably relates to that horse, completed, **signed and stamped** on each line by a veterinary surgeon, who is not the owner of the animal. It must state that the horse has two injections for primary vaccination against Equine Influenza given no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days apart. (Only these two injections need to have been given for the horse to compete). In addition a first booster injection must be given no less than 150 days and no more than 215 days after the second injection of the primary vaccination. Subsequently, booster injections must be given at intervals of not more than 1 year apart, commencing after the first booster injection. None of these injections must have been given within the **preceding 7 days**, including the day of the competition or entry into competition stables.*

Horses foaled before 1st January 1980 need not have had the first booster injection (no less 150 days and no more than 215 days) after the second injection of the primary vaccination – but must have had an annual booster (given within 12 months) thereafter.

Note: Where Passports are used as the flu' vaccination record, the horse description must be verified by a vet or authorised member of a breed society.



Winter Dressage on Sunday 9th March, 2008 at Castle Farm, Over Wallop (schedule to follow).

We are unable to return to Hoplands EC for this year's event. The improvement in their facilities came at a price to match – one which was beyond our limit. We are lucky enough to be able to use the excellent facilities at Castle Farm as an alternative. Details of tests, organisers etc will appear shortly.



Winter Show Jumping on Sunday 30th March, 2008 at Castle Farm, Over Wallop (schedule to follow)

The arenas at Castle Farm provide excellent jumping surfaces both for competition & warm up both all weather. Jumping classes will be run at heights from 2' 3" to 3' 3", with clear round jumping at 2'. Appeals for help will be made nearer the time.



Residential Camp at Stockland Lovell, Somerset 14-17th April 2008

The residential camp has been booked at Stockland Lovell. Arrival will be on Monday 14th April between 12-1pm and departure after lunch on Thursday 17th. Accommodation consists of furnished heated portacabins of various sizes, containing 2-6 bunk beds, divans, mirror, chairs and hooks for clothing. Residents will need to take their own bedding including pillows. Shower block, loos, dining room and lounge will be shared with other people staying on the premises.

Full catering will be provided and includes English breakfast, cold lunch, afternoon cakes and 2 course evening meal.

Stabling will be in an American style barn with hay and straw included, a shavings stable can be provided. Hard food will not be supplied, so we will need to take our own.

All horse must have a current flu vaccination certificate.

PLEASE READ THE VACCINATION RULES ABOVE AND CHECK THAT YOUR HORSE'S CERTIFICATE COMPLIES IN EVERY RESPECT.

The facilities at Stockland Lovell include

- an extensive cross country course with in excess of 100 fences from 1'6" to 3'9",
- two all weather arenas (one with show jumps),
- two grass arenas (one with show jumps)
- marked routes for hacking around the farm
- saddlery shop.

The plan is to have six riding sessions, Monday afternoon, 2 each on Tuesday and Wednesday and one on Thursday morning. Please indicate on the booking form the type (hacking, flatwork, gridwork, show jumping or cross country) and how many sessions of riding you would like to do (not more than 2 of each jumping type, maximum of 6 sessions). We can't promise, but we will do our best to satisfy your choice.

Our allocation is for 40-45 people. The cost will be £200 (+£16 for shavings stable) of which a £50 deposit shall be paid on return of the attached application form and the remainder will be payable on or before 1st April. Apart from under exceptional circumstances, payment will only be refunded if your allocated space can be filled.

Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Please return the booking form as soon as possible to avoid disappointment, but no later than 15th February. Priority will be given to members, friends would be welcome if space allows but there will be an extra cost of £28. General instruction sessions consist of some flatwork and, time permitting, some optional gridwork or a small course of jumps at the end. Each session will last 1½ hours.

Cross Country Instruction Body protectors are compulsory. The sessions will last for two hours.

Directions to Tweseldown Take M3 to Junction 5 (Hook). Turn right heading towards Farnham (A287). Second left at roundabout (still Farnham) and second left again at next one (still towards Farnham). Keep going along the A287 (along long straight and then up long, long hill) until you reach another roundabout; turn left (B3013) down long hill until you enter Church Crookham. First right (The Tweseldown Pub) into Bourley Road.

The instruction sessions are aimed at all levels of horse and rider – do come and have a go. If you wish to attend, please send the attached reply slip to Lindsay Hills **AT LEAST 3 DAYS BEFORE** the due date (separate cheques for each session with date marked on the back of the cheque please).

An afternoon with Sara Green, British Dressage Director

Saturday 26 January 2008, 2-6pm, Crofton Manor Equestrian Centre

Sara has a real passion for dressage to music and contributed the music element of the Bailey's training day that Sam Seagrave from Meon Riding Club won last year. Many of us have seen and enjoyed Sam and Chilli Pepper's great routine.
