BRC Insurance

As a Riding Club affiliated to the British Horse Society, BVRC carries a certain level of insurance cover. It has become apparent that clarification is needed about the insurance cover of individual club members. The policy offers third party personal liability insurance. Members will be insured whilst taking part in activities (riding or helping) organised by BVRC, another BHS affiliated Riding Club or British Riding Clubs office at Stoneleigh. Travel to and from activities is EXCLUDED. Members are NOT INSURED outside RC activities, e.g. hacking out independently. Rule Reminder

The club doesn't have too many rules, but just as a general reminder to keep everyone on the straight and narrow here are details of the ones that seem to cause most problems.

BVRC membership is open to people 17 years old or older (with no upper age limit). 16 year olds may compete in competitions and attend any riding event as a member's guest, (with permission of the organiser) but BVRC does not allow under 16's to ride at their events. They do, however, welcome guests of any age at their socials.

Anyone riding at our events MUST wear correct approved headgear. The current standard is **at least to the recommended standards PAS015 or EN1384; hats prefixed SEI or ASTM are permissible (ASTM is not valid on its own, it must have the SEI prefix)**. Hats shall have a chin strap which has a non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Hats marked EN1384, PAS015 or prefixed ASTM or SEI are the minimum standard allowed. Hard Hats to specification PAS015 or ASTM F1163 are considered to offer greater protection than EN1384. Recommended hats should carry the quality assurance stamp of Kitemark or SEI. American standard SNELL E2001 and Australian or New Zealand standard SNZ 3838 1998 are also acceptable. Where a hat is of skullcap style, this must be worn with a silk.

Such headgear shall be worn properly adjusted and fastened at all times when mounted.

A HAT WITH A FIXED PEAK IS NOT PERMISSIBLE FOR CROSS COUNTRY.

Please be aware before you turn up that you bring the right hat with you to every single riding event & competition that we run.

Body protectors (Class 3 - Purple Label) shall be worn for any event involving cross-country jumping and are strongly recommended for show jumping.

Medical armbands (armbands issued by BE and BRC) are mandatory at Club Horse Trials and Hunter Trial competitions.

For safety reasons it is not permissible to wear jewellery or any items worn in facial or body piercings whilst competing.

Chaps or half-chaps may not be worn whilst competing either. Gaiters are permissible.

There is also a rule for BRC competitions and states '*long hair should be worn in a net or secured in such way as not to hang below the collar for safety reasons*'.

Otherwise there is no particular dress code, it is sufficient just to be "clean and tidy". Correct footwear (i.e. no Muckers) is a good idea.

We have entered two teams at Crofton Manor on 15th February. I understand that the facilities have greatly improved since our last visit when the warm up arena became water logged and competitors had to resort to trotting up & down the car park before jumping.



BRC Area 17 Festival of the Hunter (FOTH) Challenge Qualifier – Sunday 19th April 2009, at Tenantry Farm, Rockbourne.

BRC Hunter Trial / Cross Country competition has metamorphosed into the Festival of the Hunter Challenge (FOTH Challenge). The competition is to test the ability of a pony/horse and rider to negotiate a show jumping course together with a piece of hunting country at a fair hunting pace. The course will consist of 7-10 show jumps followed by 8-15 cross country fences.

Area 17 Novice & Open Team, Individual & Pairs Qualifier is being held at Rockbourne. The Championships take place at Aston le Walls, Daventry, Northants, over the weekend of 30th/31st May.

The Novice & Pairs competition is set at a height of 85cm (2'9") and the Open height is 1m (3'3"). Both Novice & Open team members are eligible for the Pairs. We hope to have teams representing BVRC on 19th April.

If you are interested in participating please fill in and return the attached form to Susie Pool (01980 671523) by Wednesday 18th March

Please remember that you will need to have a fully up to date flu certificate (for your horse), and have paid your subscriptions.

There are some restrictions in the eligibility of horses and riders for the various competitions. If you wish to be considered for a place in any of the competitions, please fill in and return the attached team forms to Susie Pool, together with two photocopies of the horse's Passport / Flu vacc certificate (one copy for each competition for which you would like to be considered + one extra for Susie). **Please make sure you copy every section (front, back & middle) of the certificate – including the name & address of the owner, the horse's name, silhouette, markings & every single vaccinations entry.**

ONCE YOU HAVE RETURNED YOUR FORM PLEASE LET SUSIE KNOW IMMEDIATELY IF YOU ARE NO LONGER AVAILABLE. The team competitions cost the club a lot of money, which we do not want to waste.

The team selection policy is as follows:

On the basis of the response to the team forms, a decision is made about how many teams to enter. Details of how many teams and individuals we want to enter are sent, **with an entry fee**, to British Riding Clubs (3-4 weeks before the competition).

Anyone applying for team places will be notified if their application has been successful.

Entries detailing who is in which team is sent to the Area Competition Organiser (**with another entry fee**) about 7-10 days before the competition is held.

Following the committee decision last year, we are asking team members to make a contribution to entry fees to area qualifying competitions. We are requesting £15 for each team / individual place. Payment is to be enclosed with the application form. A refund will only be made in the event of injury / illness to horse or rider which prevents them from participating in the competition.

The club pays all entry fees to Championships.

Selection for team places is based on performance at club competitions or other known events.

It is normally the case that, subject to eligibility, anyone keen to take part will be offered the opportunity to ride for the club.

The area competitions are great events giving us the opportunity to meet and compete against other clubs in the area and participate in a team environment. We want to encourage any one interested to have a go, but in the event of teams or individuals qualifying for National Championships, we need to know in advance if you are prepared to go the Championships.

There may be many reasons why you can't or don't want to attend the Championships. It will not stop us asking you to represent the club, but it may just affect who goes in which team.

Even if you stated on your membership application that you were interested in teams, please fill in and return the team application forms.

PLEASE READ THE FLU VACC RULES SHOWN BELOW AND MAKE SURE YOUR HORSE'S Certificate COMPLIES WITH THE RULES IN EVERY RESPECT.

Equine Influenza - Valid Certificates – Vaccination procedures

*Each horse must have a valid vaccination certificate, which undeniably relates to that horse, completed, **signed and stamped** on each line by a veterinary surgeon, who is not the owner of the animal. It must state that the horse has two injections for primary vaccination against Equine Influenza given no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days apart. (Only these two injections need to have been given for the horse to compete). In addition a first booster injection must be given no less than 150 days and no more than 215 days after the second injection of the primary vaccination. Subsequently, booster injections must be given at intervals of not more than 1 year apart, commencing after the first booster injection. None of these injections must have been given within the **preceding 7 days**, including the day of the competition or entry into competition stables.*

Horses foaled before 1st January 1980 need not have had the first booster injection (no less 150 days and no more than 215 days) after the second injection of the primary vaccination – but must have had an annual booster (given within 12 months) thereafter.

Note: Where Passports are used as the flu' vaccination record, the horse description must be verified by a vet or authorised member of a breed society.

Residential Camp at Stockland Lovell, Somerset 20-23rd April 2009

The residential camp has been booked at Stockland Lovell. Arrival will be on Monday 20th April between 12-1pm and departure after lunch on Thursday 23rd. Accommodation consists of furnished heated portacabins of various sizes, containing 2-6 bunk beds, divans, mirror, chairs and hooks for clothing. Residents will need to take their own bedding including pillows. Shower block, loos, dining room and lounge are available on the premises.

Full catering will be provided and includes English breakfast, cold lunch, afternoon cakes and 2 course evening meal.

Stabling will be in an American style barn with hay and straw included. A shavings stable can be provided but there is a choice of purchasing shavings at cost from SL or bringing your own. Either way, the stable will need to be completely cleared before departure. Hard food will not be supplied, so we will need to take our own.

All horse must have a current flu vaccination certificate.

PLEASE READ THE VACCINATION RULES ABOVE AND CHECK THAT YOUR HORSE'S CERTIFICATE COMPLIES IN EVERY RESPECT.

The facilities at Stockland Lovell include

- an extensive cross country course with in excess of 100 fences from 1'6" to 3'9",
- two all weather arenas (one with show jumps),
- two grass arenas (one with show jumps)
- marked routes for hacking around the farm
- saddlery shop.

The plan is to have six riding sessions, Monday afternoon, 2 each on Tuesday and Wednesday and one on Thursday morning.

Please indicate on the booking form the type (hacking, flatwork, gridwork, show jumping or cross country) and how many sessions of riding you would like to do (not more than 2 of each jumping type, maximum of 6 sessions). We can't promise, but we will do our best to satisfy your choice.

Our allocation is for 40-45 people / horses. The cost will be £215 of which a £65 deposit shall be paid on return of the attached application form and the remainder will be payable on or before 1st April. Shavings supplied by SL will need to be paid for separately (costs to be confirmed). A second horse may be brought, if space permits, at a cost of £60.

Apart from under exceptional circumstances, payment will only be refunded if your allocated space can be filled.

Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Please return the booking form as soon as possible to avoid disappointment, but no later than 20th February. Priority will be given to members, friends would be welcome if space allows but there will be an extra cost of £35. General instruction sessions consist of some flatwork and, time permitting, some optional gridwork or a small course of jumps at the end. Each session will last 1½ hours.

Cross Country Instruction Body protectors are compulsory. The sessions will last for 2 hours.

Directions to Tweseldown Take M3 to Junction 5 (Hook). Turn right heading towards Farnham (A287). Second left at roundabout (still Farnham) and second left again at next one (still towards Farnham). Keep going along the A287 (along long straight and then up long, long hill) until you reach another roundabout; turn left (B3013) down long hill until you enter Church Crookham. First right (The Tweseldown Pub) into Bourley Road.

The instruction sessions are aimed at all levels of horse and rider – do come and have a go. If you wish to attend, please send the attached reply slip to Lindsay Hills **AT LEAST 3 DAYS BEFORE** the due date (separate cheques for each session with date marked on the back of the cheque please).
