BRC Insurance

As a Riding Club affiliated to the British Horse Society, BVRC carries a certain level of insurance cover. It has become apparent that clarification is needed about the insurance cover of individual club members. The policy offers third party personal liability insurance. Members will be insured whilst taking part in activities (riding or helping) organised by BVRC, another BHS affiliated Riding Club or Riding Clubs office at Stoneleigh. Travel to and from activities is EXCLUDED. Members are NOT INSURED outside RC activities, e.g. hacking out independently. Competition Entries & Withdrawals

Just a friendly reminder, the organisation & running of events require enormous effort. Please try to ensure you don't add to the burden unnecessarily.

1. Read the schedule carefully including **ALL** the rules and conditions of entry.
2. Note & stick to times for telephoning organisers / secretaries – particularly for class riding times.
3. Do NOT phone at unsocial hours.
4. Having entered a competition, if you are then unable to attend, please notify organisers / secretaries asap.
There may be others on a waiting list, desperate for a place.
5. Please be courteous at all times, even when stressed or when things aren't going to plan.
6. Don't be frightened to ask for help or advice. Keep officials informed if you are experiencing a problem.

Remember we are all volunteers who are doing our best, giving up time for your enjoyment.

We hope that everyone, organisers, secretaries, helpers and competitors all have a happy and successful competition season.

We are entering the busiest part of the club year for competitions. We need to move trailers and caravans to and from competition venues. Without them we are unable to run our events. Rule Reminder

The club doesn't have too many rules, but just as a general reminder to keep everyone on the straight and narrow here are details of the ones that seem to cause most problems.

BVRC membership is open to people 17 years old or older (with no upper age limit). 16 year olds may compete in competitions and attend any riding event as a member's guest, (with permission of the organiser) but BVRC does not allow under 16's to ride at their events. They do however, welcome guests of any age at their socials.

Anyone riding at our events MUST wear correct approved headgear. The current standard is **at least to the recommended standards PAS015 or EN1384; hats prefixed SEI or ASTM are permissible (ASTM is not valid on its own, it must have the SEI prefix)**. Hats shall have a chin strap which has a non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Hats marked EN1384, PAS015 or prefixed ASTM or SEI are the minimum standard allowed. Hard Hats to specification PAS015 or ASTM F1163 are considered to offer greater protection than EN1384. Recommended hats should carry the quality assurance stamp of Kitemark or SEI. American standard SNELL E2001 and Australian or New Zealand standard SNZ 3838 1998 are also acceptable. Where a hat is of skullcap style, this must be worn with a silk. Such headgear shall be worn properly adjusted and fastened at all times when mounted.

PLEASE NOTE FROM 1st APRIL A HAT WITH A FIXED PEAK IS NOT PERMISSIBLE FOR CROSS COUNTRY.

Please be aware before you turn up that you bring the right hat with you. This rule also applies to every single riding event & competition that we run.

Body protectors (Class 3 - Purple Label) shall be worn for any event involving cross-country jumping and are strongly recommended for show jumping.

Medical armbands (armbands issued by BE and BRC) are mandatory at Club One Day event and Hunter Trial competitions.

For safety reasons it is not permissible to wear jewellery or any items worn in facial or body piercings whilst competing.

Chaps or half-chaps may not be worn whilst competing either.

There is also a rule for BRC competitions and states '*long hair should be worn in a net or secured in such way as not to hang below the collar for safety reasons*'.

Otherwise there is no particular dress code, it is sufficient just to be "clean and tidy". Correct footwear (i.e. no Muckers) is a good idea.

What a horrendous day!! It was windy and wet all day and the ground was still so wet from previous rains that the field where the trailers parked last year could not be used. As a result ALL vehicles had to park in the lorry park (18 teams of 4 riders)!! The stewards did brilliantly to fit everyone in (JUST!) with everyone double parked but still able to unload. Less successful was the warming up facilities. After half the teams in the first round had ridden, the outdoor school became very unevenly boggy but the remaining team members were not permitted to use a fence in the indoor arena for practice until the 2nd round started. By this time everyone was warming up along a track between the fields. Sadly our teams did not fare well either in spite of the splendid clear start by Annabel, who started the whole competition off. Helen trail-blazed for the White Team and 4 four down as Charliesolo thought this was rather different from the hunting he has down all winter! They were closely followed by Laura who had already competed in the 1st (individual non-qualifier) class, as a warm-up. I had high hopes as they had been placed in this but Laura forgot that the course had changed and tried to jump the same one again, which lead to her elimination. Feeling full of remorse she was cheered by the news that she could make up for it in the 2nd round. Next in their team was Ruth, who completed a stylish clear but Charlotte's very green, young mare couldn't cope with the whole scenario and didn't complete the course. Sadly, with only 2 riders able to count, the team was eliminated. The White Team had a better 1st round with Cath & Tango going clear – she felt it was the best, most relaxed round they had ever done – Kelly having only one down and Elizabeth doing a beautiful clear on her lovely Medium dressage horse.

Helen and Charliesolo had a much improved 2nd round with only 2 down but Tango had the time to wind herself up this time so in her excitement had 3 down. Kelly had one down again in this round but Elizabeth completed her day with a clean sheet, utterly delighted with her little horse who had beaten Lizzie Murray (nee Lorrison-Clark) in a Medium test 2 days before!
