BVRC - Hampshire Fire and Rescue - Animal rescue Talk
on Tuesday 17th November 2009 The Red Lion, Clanville 7.15pm for a prompt 7.30pm start

Who would you trust to rescue your horse in a real emergency?

For many years Hampshire's firefighters have responded to all kinds of incidents involving animals and have been largely successful using their amazing ingenuity and dedication. Large animal rescue however is recognised as one of the most dangerous activities a firefighter will be engaged in and so to protect firefighters and members of the public, specialised training and equipment is essential.

Anton Philips, Hampshire's Rural Safety Officer, will be presenting to Bourne Valley Riding Club members and friends on the service that Hampshire Fire and Rescue provide, including what to expect if you and your horse end up in a tricky predicament. Large animal rescue is all about team work and in order to achieve the best possible outcome it is vital that as many owners/riders/onlookers know what to, and what not to, do in an emergency situation.

Come along for an interesting and informative evening, enjoy a jacket potato during the interval (must be pre-ordered, see below) and take away some good tips - you never know when you might need them.
