**British Riding Clubs Area 17 Winter League, 2007/2008 starting on 17<sup>th</sup> November**

BRC Area 17 Winter League will be running again this winter season, returning to Sparsholt College, near Winchester. These are very good competitions against members from other riding clubs in the area. The shows are well organised with limited entries – so there is no hanging around for hours between classes. Members placed in each class accrue points for the club and for themselves in the individual competition. At the end of the series there is a prize for the club with the most points, and the individual with the most points who has taken part in both dressage & show jumping (but not necessarily placed in both). Please have a go and help BVRC to retain the title we won in 2005.

Dressage on 20<sup>th</sup> January will include a new BRC Area 17 Winter Team Dressage Qualifier. The team comprises 4 members, 2 to ride a Prelim Test & 2 to ride a Novice Test. Championships will take place at Hartpury College on 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> April 2008, alongside the Novice Indoor Show Jumping Championships. We will be asking for potential team members in due course.

## **Physiotherapy Lecture-Demonstration by Elle Tisch Cat A ACPAT, BSc Phys, MCSP, from Amanda Sutton's Physiotherapy Practice at Castle Farm Indoor School, Sat 13 Oct 07**

Question – What was I doing in an Indoor School dressed in only my Bra and jods in the middle of October?

Answer – Regretting that I ever agreed that it would be a good idea!

Let me explain.

Over the summer on one of the infrequent warm days, my horse was visited by Elle Tishe of Amanda Suttons Animal Physiotherapy Practice. As part of the general chat, we came up with the idea to give a demonstration of how the rider may influence the horse's way of going through their posture or previous injuries. Hence me and my big mouth agreeing to be a guinea pig. Susie Pool then came up with the idea that we should ride in our Bras and she would ask if LessBounce, the sports bra suppliers in Netheravon, would sponsor it.

So the day dawned relatively warm for October and all congregated at Castle Farm. After a brief introduction by Elle, it was time for self assessment. First of all, a questionnaire which got you thinking about ways that you perform tasks and if pain or reduced mobility was stopping you doing certain tasks fully. Then everyone was on their feet adopting various postures to test our range of movements. The greatest test I thought was standing on one leg and squatting, seeing how stable you were doing it and if your knee stayed straight in front of you or veered one way or the other. Next it was the familiar test of touching your toes – huge embarrassment for Susie as her (80 plus) mother did it easily and Susie (40 plus) didn't! Elle also emphasised that none of us should be in pain and we should prioritise ourselves in the pecking order of life – how often do we sweep our problems/feelings away as not important and place others in front of us. Something which rings very true in my life!

Health and safety then reared its ugly head and all the spectators had to move into the viewing gallery whilst the horses and riders were brought in; myself on my relatively new acquisition, Sleeve, my daughter Laura on her Jeebs and Vanessa Martin on her grey, Dublin. Displaying our beautifully fitted bra/crop tops each of us rode in front of the crowd. Elle assessed us each, giving comments on how our bodies were crooked, shoulders higher, sides collapsing, head wobbling, etc and how that may affect the horse. I could never understand why my daughter's left elbow always stuck out – but having seen her in just her crop top were we able to see that her left side collapsed so there is no space for her elbow - it has to stick out! As for me – Elle put some tapes on my back at the base of my shoulder blades and also on the points of my horse's hips. As I turned away from the crowds they gave a collective gasp (admiration or consternation?) as my left shoulder is significantly lower than the right. Fortunately, this is counterbalanced by my horse having a higher right hip than left so we should work in perfect harmony!

So the conclusion that we can all gain from the demonstration, is that riders can influence the horse's way of going – equally horses can influence the rider's way of going.

Please everyone be bold one day and strip off – not only is it extremely liberating – it is also extremely enlightening!

I must say a huge thank you to LessBounce. My boobs have never been under such control and I find the bra really comfortable. Laura loves the support and colour of hers (bright pink!) and has used it every day since for riding or sports. We are both going to ride in them next summer to top up our tans and hopefully not cause too many accidents on the roads!
