NEWSLETTER APRIL 2002

The competition season made an impressive start with our Winter Dressage & Show Jumping returning to Hoplands EC after an absence of four years. We noticed a huge improvement in the facilities. The super new surfaces and specific large car parking area makes Hoplands an excellent competition venue. Attendance at both Shows exceeded expectations. Dressage classes were full. Some juggling of entries between classes was necessary, but nobody was turned away. It was lovely to see so many new members taking part, and, not that I was paying particular attention, a lot more male competitors than normal! Membership is gradually creeping up to last year's level (237 registered at head office) and currently stands at 232. Apart from a static year in 2001, membership has increased every year for the past ten years, in 1992, standing at around 50. An article on 'Membership Statistics 2001', in the Winter 2002 edition of the "Rider", the official Magazine of British Riding Clubs, proved interesting reading. It is several years since any statistics have been published. It was of particular interest to note that Area 17, of which we are part, is the largest with 2336 members. Although BVRC was not mentioned in dispatches, our membership numbers are up amongst those listed as having the largest number of senior members. Our aim, this year, is to make the top five list. In case you think we are slacking, this Newsletter shows a variety of events – hopefully something for everybody.

Inter Club Teams Competitions

Our club is one of twenty designated to British Riding Clubs Area 17. Geographically the area covers the central south of England, stretching from Petersfield in the East to Blandford and Purbeck in the West & includes the Isle of Wight. Our club sits on the northern edge of the area.

Each year inter club team competitions are organised in Show Jumping, Horse Trials and Dressage. The winning teams and individuals from these competitions and from all other Areas around Great Britain go forward to National Riding Club Championships at the end of the summer. The Horse Trials Championships is held at Offchurch Bury, Nr Leamington Spa. The Championships for all other events will be held at the Lincolnshire Showground for the first time.

Teams comprise four members, with the best three scores accrued to give the team total.

There are two main requirements for members wishing to take part in the above competitions.

1. The horse must be owned by a club member or a documented long term lease agreement be in existence.
2. The horse must have valid up to date Flu Vaccination Certificate, which must comply in every respect to the rules shown below.

There are some restrictions in the eligibility of horses and riders for the various competitions, so it is that dreaded time again. If you wish to be considered for a team place in any of the competition please fill in and return the attached Team forms to Sam Mawer, together with a photocopy of the horse's Flu vacc certificate (one copy for each competition for you would like to be considered). There are two forms, the first for all the Dressage Competitions to be returned by **19th April for Dressage to Music & 1st June for all other dressage tests** and the second for Show Jumping and Horse Trials teams to be returned by **15th May**.

The team selection policy is as follows:

On the basis of the response to the Team forms, a decision is made about how many teams to enter. Selection for team places is based on performance at club competitions or other known events.

It is normally the case that, subject to eligibility, anyone keen to take part will be offered a team place.

The club pays all Entry Fees to Area competitions.

If you think you would like to have a go but are not sure then ring Sam for a chat. Otherwise, even if you stated on your membership application that you were interested in teams, please fill in and return your forms.

Equine Influenza - Valid Certificates – Vaccination procedures

*Each horse must have a valid vaccination certificate, which undeniably relates to that horse, completed, **signed and stamped** on each line by a veterinary surgeon, who is not the owner of the animal. It must state that the horse has two injections for primary vaccination against Equine Influenza given no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days apart. (Only these two injections need to have been given for the horse to compete). In addition a first booster injection must be given no less than 150 days and no more than 215 days after the second injection of the primary vaccination. Subsequently, booster injections must be given at intervals of not more than 1 year apart, commencing after the first booster injection. None of these injections must have been given within the **preceding 7 days**, including the day of the competition or entry into competition stables.*

Horses foaled before 1st January 1980 need not have had the first booster injection (no less 150 days and no more than 215 days) after the second injection of the primary vaccination – but must have had an annual booster (given within 12 months) thereafter.
