Back protectors are compulsory. The sessions will last for two hours.

Directions to Tweseldown Take M3 to Junction 5 (Hook). Turn right heading towards Farnham (A287). Second left at roundabout (still Farnham) and second left again at next one (still towards Farnham). Keep going along the A287 (along long straight and then up long, long hill) until you reach another roundabout; turn left (B3013) down long hill until you enter Church Crookham. First right (The Tweseldown Pub) into Bourley Road.

Bob joined the club in 1969, on his return to Larkhill, after finishing his military service. He represented the club at both Area and Championship level in Show Jumping and Horse Trials teams for many years. Always enthusiastic, Bob was a staunch club supporter and could be seen helping and encouraging his wife, Helen, at club events until the last couple of years. As a onetime army rough rider, Bob was a great horseman, one greatly admired by us all. He last rode aged 92 years! He will be greatly missed. Our thoughts and sympathies are with Helen.

More information about HorseWorld

HorseWorld is a registered charity No 206749, based just outside Bristol in Whitchurch. We were formed by volunteers in 1952 to care for unwanted horses and ponies from agricultural and industrial backgrounds, such as farming and the coal mines. Many of these animals still had several years of life left, and our volunteers saved as many as possible from unnecessary slaughter. Today the charity has evolved into a respected equine organisation, concentrating on rescuing, rehabilitating and re-homing horses, ponies and donkeys in need. We have responsibility for approximately 350 equines from our site south of Bristol, and re-homed over 100 horses in 2004 alone.

HorseWorld has two sites, our Welfare Yard, where sick, neglected or traumatised horses and ponies come to recover; and our Visitor Centre, where the public can meet some of our recovered animals. We hope that visitors will enjoy their day out at the Centre, and will also learn about animal welfare whilst they are here. It costs so much to look after a horse or pony properly, and we hope that we can help to educate people before they consider taking a new animal on.

Our three R's – rescue, rehabilitation and re-homing – form the basis of our work. We accept animals from all kinds of backgrounds; from abandonments, cruelty cases or where an owner has passed away or simply cannot cope any more. We assess all of our animals when they arrive, and then start each animal on a programme of rehabilitation. The exact work we do with our horses and ponies depends on their age and temperaments, but it might include curing a fear of traffic, getting them used to being ridden, or helping them to overcome their fear of people after a traumatic start in life. We then try to re-home as many animals as possible with loving new families. We thoroughly check the new homes and loaners (we maintain legal ownership of all our animals), and keep any eye on them with six-monthly visits. It is tremendously rewarding to see a once scared and timid pony being given a loving new home with people that really care.

All of our work costs a lot of money – over half a million pounds each year – and we are very lucky to have supporters that donate money, time, or leave gifts to us in their Will. We are, however, not rich, and we are always grateful for more help!

Our key aim at the moment is to encourage people to recycle their used printer cartridges, mobile 'phones and stamps with us. Recycling doesn't cost our supporters anything, but it really helps us. We have partnerships with different companies, and receive money for all these items.

We collect the used stamps our supporters send us, whether they are modern, British, foreign or older stamps, and sell them to raise money. The stamps must be in good condition for us to be able to sell them. Mobile Phones

We can also raise money with old mobile phones. Please get in touch for a freepost mobile phone recycling bag. We can get money for any mobile phone with or without the charger.

Printer and Fax Cartridges

We also can raise vital funds from used laser and inkjet printer cartridges. We can provide you with either a freepost bag for up to 2 small inkjet cartridges, or boxes for larger quantities of both inkjet or laser cartridges.
