BRC Area 17 Novice Indoor Show Jumping Qualifier **on Sunday 4th March 2007 at Crofton Manor, Stubbington, Nr Fareham.**

This is an early call for the first of the Area 17 qualifying competitions for 2007. Teams of four riders compete over two rounds, with jumps 80cm (2'6") in the first and 85cm (2'9") in the second round. The team total is made up from the best three scores in each round. The winning teams go forward to National Championships at Hartpury College EC on 14th April.

Horses with any BSJA winnings, BE points or BE Pre-Novice 1st – 6th placings are ineligible.

BRC Area 17 Novice Hunter Trial Qualifier – Sunday 1st April 2007, at Tenantry Farm, Rockbourne.

BRC Area 17 Novice & Open Team & Individual Hunter Trial Qualifier is being held at Rockbourne this year. The Hunter Trial championships take place at Ashton le Walls, Daventry, Northants, on Sunday 3rd June.

The Novice competition is set at a height of 85cm (2'9") and the Open height is 1m (3'3"). Teams comprise of four members with the best 3 scores making up the team total. We hope to have teams representing BVRC on 1st April.

If you are interested in being part of a team please fill in and return the attached form to Susie Pool (01980 671523) by the Thursday 1st March. We need to decide by the 6th March how many teams to enter.

Please remember that you will need to have a fully up to date flu certificate (for your horse), and have paid your subscriptions.

Please Note: riders may only compete for one club in any competition year.

The team selection policy is as follows:

On the basis of the response of the team forms, a decision is made about how many teams to enter.

Selection for team places is based on performance at club competitions or other known events and willingness to go to the Championships if we are good enough to qualify.

It is normally the case that, subject to eligibility, anyone keen to take part will be offered a team place.

If you think you would like to have a go but are not sure then ring Susie (01980 671523) for a chat. Otherwise, even if you stated on your membership application that you were interested in teams, please fill in and return your form.

The club pays all Entry Fees to Area competitions.

PLEASE READ THE VACCINATION RULES BELOW AND CHECK THAT YOUR HORSE'S CERTIFICATE COMPLIES IN EVERY RESPECT.

Equine Influenza - Valid Certificates – Vaccination procedures

*Each horse must have a valid vaccination certificate, which undeniably relates to that horse, completed, **signed and stamped** on each line by a veterinary surgeon, who is not the owner of the animal. It must state that the horse has two injections for primary vaccination against Equine Influenza given no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days apart. (Only these two injections need to have been given for the horse to compete). In addition a first booster injection must be given no less than 150 days and no more than 215 days after the second injection of the primary vaccination. Subsequently, booster injections must be given at intervals of not more than 1 year apart, commencing after the first booster injection. None of these injections must have been given within the **preceding 7 days**, including the day of the competition or entry into competition stables.*

Horses foaled before 1st January 1980 need not have had the first booster injection (no less 150 days and no more than 215 days) after the second injection of the primary vaccination – but must have had an annual booster (given within 12 months) thereafter.

Note: Where Passports are used as the flu' vaccination record, the horse description must be verified by a vet or authorised member of a breed society.

Residential Camp at Stockland Lovell, Somerset 16-19th April 2007

The residential camp has been booked at Stockland Lovell. Arrival will be on Monday 16th April between 12-1pm and departure after lunch on Thursday 19th. Accommodation consists of furnished heated portacabins of various sizes, containing 2-6 bunk beds, divans, mirror, chairs and hooks for clothing. Residents will need to take their own bedding including pillows. Shower block, loos, dining room and lounge will be shared with other people staying on the premises.

Full catering will be provided and includes English breakfast, cold lunch, afternoon cakes and 2 course evening meal.

Stabling will be in an American style barn with hay and straw included, a shavings stable can be provided at an extra cost of £10 (extra shavings available at £5 per bale). Hard food will not be supplied, so we will need to take our own.

All horse must have a current flu vaccination certificate.

PLEASE READ THE VACCINATION RULES ABOVE AND CHECK THAT YOUR HORSE'S CERTIFICATE COMPLIES IN EVERY RESPECT.

The facilities at Stockland Lovell include

- an extensive cross country course with in excess of 100 fences from 1'6" to 3'9",
- two all weather arenas (one with show jumps),
- two grass arenas (one with show jumps)
- marked routes for hacking around the farm
- saddlery shop.

The plan is to have six riding sessions, Monday afternoon, 2 each on Tuesday and Wednesday and one on Thursday morning.

Please indicate on the booking form the type (hacking, flatwork, gridwork, show jumping or cross country) and how many sessions of riding you would like to do (not more than 2 of each jumping type, maximum of 6 sessions). We can't promise, but we will do our best to satisfy your choice.

Our allocation is for 40-45 people. The cost will be £190 (+£10 for shavings stable) of which a £50 deposit shall be paid on return of the attached application form and the remainder will be payable on or before 1st April. Apart from under exceptional circumstances, payment will only be refunded if your allocated space can be filled.

Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Please return the booking form as soon as possible to avoid disappointment, but no later than 3rd February. Priority will be given to members, friends would be welcome if space allows at an extra cost of £25. General instruction sessions consist of some flatwork and, time permitting, some optional gridwork or a small course of jumps at the end. Each session will last 1½ hours.

Cross Country Instruction Body protectors are compulsory. The sessions will last for two hours.

Directions to Tweseldown Take M3 to Junction 5 (Hook). Turn right heading towards Farnham (A287). Second left at roundabout (still Farnham) and second left again at next one (still towards Farnham). Keep going along the A287 (along long straight and then up long, long hill) until you reach another roundabout; turn left (B3013) down long hill until you enter Church Crookham. First right (The Tweseldown Pub) into Bourley Road.

The instruction sessions are aimed at all levels of horse and rider – do come and have a go. If you wish to attend, please send the attached reply slip to Lindsay Hills **AT LEAST 3 DAYS BEFORE** the due date (separate cheques for each session with date marked on the back of the cheque please).

Spanish Riding School Trip

Ten of us, in two vehicles, braved the atrocious, wet & windy conditions, to visit the Wembley Arena and see the Spanish Riding School performance. We had good seats and the evening was enjoyed by everyone. The group booking entitled us to watch the free, pre-show masterclass where the various scales of training were explained. I sat in awe of the brilliant riding where you could hardly see the aids given by the rider, except those that were being exaggerated so we *could* actually see what was going on. The main performance again showed the various levels horses were at in their training and we were treated to a wonderful Pas de Deux, the famous leaps and jumps ('movements above the ground') and an amazing Quadrille at the end. This Quadrille lasted for 20 minutes and was not only ridden perfectly with each horse and rider in time but they all actually remembered the routine! A great end to a great evening.

Rights of Way Problems in Hampshire.

Below is a step by step guide that I have put together on how horse riders (or dog walkers, joggers etc.) who live or ride in Hampshire can report Rights of Way problems to Hampshire County Council quickly, using the Internet. It is very useful for blocked and overgrown bridleways, poached surfaces, over zealous ploughing, locked gates etc.

I've had some success using it and the more people who are aware of it the more likely we are to improve our access to off road riding for all.

Reporting Bridleway problems to Hampshire County Council:

1. go to: <http://www.hants.gov.uk/maps/paths/> (this is a link and should take you straight there....)
2. Click on 'GO TO MAPS'
3. Identify in the boxes the area where the problem is, either by postcode, village name or clicking on the approximate area on the map.
4. Select the correct area from the box.
5. You can navigate around the map using the 'zoom in / out' magnifying glass buttons, by adjusting the scale to cover a larger or smaller area and by clicking on the blue triangles on the map margins to pan up / down or diagonally.
6. When you have the problem area identified click in the 'i' information button on the right
7. Put the cursor on the bridleway in question, as near as possible to the problem if possible, and click.
8. A box will appear with the reference number of the path, the grid references, location, type of path and a small map with a red dot where you clicked.
9. Click on the blue text: [Report problem](#)
10. Click on the arrow on the right side of the box containing 'Select the Problem'. A series of problem areas will appear such as 'surface'
11. A further selection of problems will appear such as 'Flooded', 'Potholes', 'Wheel ruts' etc. Tick as many as are relevant by clicking on the boxes before each problem
12. In the next box type as much information as possible about the problem. Keep it precise and state evidence where available such as rider injuries, ripped clothing, horse falls etc.
13. In the next box enter details of the landowner if known. Even the name of the farm (if relevant) can be helpful
14. In the next boxes enter your contact details and press the 'Submit' button
