Subscriptions

Subscriptions were due for renewal on 1st November. If you have already renewed your subscriptions please skip to the next section, otherwise please read on.

Subscriptions have been set at £22 for Riding Members and £12 for Non-Riding Members. We are offering a discount to £18 for second and subsequent members of the same household. Enclosed is a membership renewal form. There are lots of good things happening so we hope that you rejoin soon.

Be Fair Cup and Caballine Trophy

The Be Fair Cup and Caballine Trophy are presented annually at the AGM.

Be Fair points are awarded to the 6 highest placed BV members in every competition regardless of their overall places (they may be 10th in the class but 2nd best BV member). Riders are only eligible for points on one horse on any particular day. Members who compete in teams on behalf of the BVRC will receive three points per day.

The Caballine Trophy points are awarded on a point for each hour or part hour worked at a show or setting up the day before a show. Committee members who organise the events only get points on this basis and not for other committee duties. Even so, the top places do seem to be filled by them. A rose bowl is awarded to the highest placed non-committee member.

In addition to the trophies, rosettes are presented to the top ten places in each competition. Each Trophy winner is awarded free membership for the following year.

Rule Reminder

The club doesn't have too many rules, but just as a general reminder to keep everyone on the straight and narrow here are details of the ones that seem to cause most problems.

BVRC membership is open to people 17 years old or older (with no upper age limit). 16 year olds may compete in competitions and attend any riding event as a member's guest, (with permission of the organiser) but BVRC does not allow under 16's to ride at their events. They do however, welcome guests of any age at their socials.

Anyone riding at our events MUST wear correct approved headgear. The current standard is **at least to the recommended standards PAS015 or EN1384; hats prefixed SEI or ASTM are permissible (ASTM is not valid on its own, it must have the SEI prefix)**. Hats shall have a chin strap which has a non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Hats marked EN1384, PAS015 or prefixed ASTM or SEI are the minimum standard allowed. Hard Hats to specification PAS015 or ASTM F1163 are considered to offer greater protection than EN1384. Recommended hats should carry the quality assurance stamp of Kitemark or SEI. American standard SNELL E95 and Australian or New Zealand standard SNZ 3838 1998 are also acceptable. Where a hat is of skullcap style, this must be worn with a silk, which may be coloured for cross country. Such headgear shall be worn properly adjusted and fastened at all times when mounted.

Bit unflattering perhaps, but we are not insured if we allow people to ride in incorrect headgear, so please be aware before you turn up and bring the right hat with you.

Body protectors (Class 3 - Purple Label) shall be worn for any event involving cross country jumping and are strongly recommended for show jumping.

Otherwise there is no particular dress code, it is sufficient just to be "clean and tidy". Correct footwear (i.e. no Muckers) is a good idea. Jewellery lovers please note, for safety reasons it is not permissible to wear earrings or studs whilst competing.

There is also rule for BRC competitions and states '*long hair should be worn in a net or secured in such way as not to hang below the collar for safety reasons*'.

Please Note: Medical armbands (armbands issued by BE and BRC are acceptable) are mandatory at Club One Day event and Hunter Trial competitions.

Full details of the rules are shown in the club's constitution. Copies can be obtained from Lindsay 01264 772388.

Equine Passports

Under new EU legislation **ALL** equines must have a DEFRA approved passport by 28th February 2005. Failure to comply with the legislation may lead to a fine of up to £5,000, or a custodial prison sentence for the owner. As of 28 February 2005 a passport must be presented whenever an equine moves premises, enters a competition, is used for breeding, leaves the UK, is sold, or when it is presented for slaughter.

Area 17 Novice Indoor Show Jumping Qualifier on Sunday 6th March 2005 at Quob Stables, Durley.

This is an early call for the first of the Area 17 qualifying competitions for 2005. Teams of four riders compete over two rounds, with jumps 2'6" in the first and 2'9" in the second round. The team total is made up from the best three scores in each round. The winning teams go forward to National Championships at Hartpury College EC on 2nd April.

Horses with any BSJA winnings or BE points are ineligible.

If you are interested in being part of a team please fill in and return the attached form to Susie Pool (01980 671523) by the Saturday 5th February. We need to decide by the 8th February how many teams to enter. Please remember that you will need to have a fully up to date flu certificate (for your horse), and have paid your subscriptions.

Please Note: riders may only compete for one club in any competition year.

The team selection policy is as follows:

On the basis of the response of the team forms, a decision is made about how many teams are entered.

Selection for team places is based on performance at club competitions or other known events and willingness to go to the Championships if we are good enough to qualify.

It is normally the case that, subject to eligibility, anyone keen to take part will be offered a team place.

If you think you would like to have a go but are not sure then ring Susie (01980 671523) for a chat. Otherwise, even if you stated on your membership application that you were interested in teams, please fill in and return your form.

The club pays all Entry Fees to Area competitions.

PLEASE READ THE VACCINATION RULES BELOW AND CHECK THAT YOUR HORSE'S CERTIFICATE COMPLIES IN EVERY RESPECT.

Equine Influenza - Valid Certificates – Vaccination procedures

*Each horse must have a valid vaccination certificate, which undeniably relates to that horse, completed, **signed and stamped** on each line by a veterinary surgeon, who is not the owner of the animal. It must state that the horse has two injections for primary vaccination against Equine Influenza given no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days apart. (Only these two injections need to have been given for the horse to compete). In addition a first booster injection must be given no less than 150 days and no more than 215 days after the second injection of the primary vaccination. Subsequently, booster injections must be given at intervals of not more than 1 year apart, commencing after the first booster injection. None of these injections must have been given within the **preceding 7 days**, including the day of the competition or entry into competition stables.*

Horses foaled before 1st January 1980 need not have had the first booster injection (no less 150 days and no more than 215 days) after the second injection of the primary vaccination – but must have had an annual booster (given within 12 months) thereafter.



British Riding Clubs Area 17 Winter League, 12th March

Sparsholt College, near Winchester, is hosting the last of the Area 17 Winter Show Jumping and Dressage Series with Dressage on the 12th March. BVRC are currently in the lead for the team competition and club members Kay Bugden and Carol Dunford occupy first, second & third places individually. A lot hinges on the final dressage competition so we hope plenty of you will take part. The competitions are open to members of affiliated Riding Clubs who have registered to take part (which the BVRC has). Flu certificates must accompany the horse to the event for spot checks. No entries taken on the day. Please read the rules carefully to avoid disappointment! 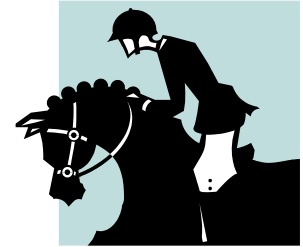

Visit to Toby Balding's Racing Stables, Kimpton Down

Thirty four members, family and friends turned out for this lovely visit on a bright Saturday morning. We shared the visit to this purpose built yard with the Kimpton Down Race Club which boosted the numbers. Welcomed by Toby Balding, refreshments were served in a huge informal meeting room where the walls were adorned with paintings and photographs of the trainer's victorious charges. We were then introduced to Jonathan Geake, Toby's son in law, who has taken over the licence following his retirement. We watched second lot pull out of the yard whilst listening to Toby describe each horse as it went past; a bit about its breeding, whether and how it had run and his hopes for it's future. The establishment has an exercise gallop close by and a walk up the hill behind the yard gave us a good view of the 4 furlong all weather loop set in the land now between us and the stables. The horses worked in walk, then trot, then canter several times around the loop before branching off and coming up the hill past us – still on an all weather surface but this still provided us with the terrific sound of their thundering hooves. Toby described this as 'the best sound in the world' which I think may be true! He again provided excellent commentary whilst we watched the horses work on the loop and gallop. A further walk over the brow of the hill revealed his 'old' grass and all weather gallops which looked magnificent set in the valley below. After watching the horses work, we went back down to the yard and were invited to look round at our leisure, enabling us to get a real close up of the horses and their facilities. We were made most welcome by Toby, and the team and this visit proved interesting to everyone whether they were horsey or not. Another visit at some stage would almost certainly be on the cards.
