**Visit to Greatwood Thoroughbred Rehabilitation and Re-homing centre** on Saturday April 16th at

9:30am Clench Common, near Marlborough.

Greatwood is dedicated to the rescue, rehabilitation and re-homing of racehorses. Established in Devon 13 years ago as a registered charity (No. 1077080) their aim is to provide the racehorses that enter the Charity with safe secure and rewarding futures. They aim to take in as many as possible, to restore their morale and to retrain them for happy and useful lives in other disciplines. This visit will provide an insight into the knowledgeable and attentive care required to ensure that wherever possible, the horses that arrive at Greatwood may, after a period of perhaps up to 18 months, be found a suitable, new and caring home. Unfortunately the 'Hall of Fame' has had to close for Health and Safety reasons and the charity has insufficient funds to re-open it for the foreseeable future. However, during the morning there will be a walk around the facilities and the staff will give an explanation of their work. We will then be able to meet the horses, those suitable for re-homing and members of the small permanent sanctuary.

### **AREA 17 NOVICE TEAMS INDOOR SHOW JUMPING QUALIFIER, 6<sup>th</sup> March 2005**

Seven horses and riders plus supporters pitched up at Quob Equestrian Centre, Durley for the Area Novice Teams Indoor Qualifiers, alongside 14 other teams. The sun was glorious but the wind bitter and between rounds everyone kept well wrapped up. Bourne Valley had entered 2 teams for this qualifier having had much prior interest, although I had a major panic in the preceding 48 hours as several team members, and my reserves (!) had to withdraw for veterinary reasons! Thankfully Julie Newman stepped into the breach at the last minute so we did field two teams, albeit one with only 3 members. The second minor heart stopper was when I got home after a dinner party with friends at 1am the night before the competition to pick up a phone message saying that there was a problem with the flu certificate for Steve Tomkins' horse. There couldn't be – I checked them all!!! I looked again – yup, the vet had obviously accidentally put the wrong year for the second prelim vaccination (giving it the same year as the next jab). Thankfully, Peter Buist (Area 17 BRC rep and Technical Steward) agreed that it was so obviously a clerical error (otherwise

the second listed job would have been given after the third listed job) that the flu certificate was accepted as "in date". Just goes to show that with a total of 12 members declaring an interest, we actually competed with 6 of them plus another co-opted.

With very few poles falling in the first round at 2'6", there was everything to ride for in the second. However the increased height to 2'9" and a change of course sorted the wheat from the chaff; poles and planks dropped like ninepins to make a real competition of it. Unfortunately the one pole dropped by a BV member in the first round was in the team of 3 so it could not be the discard score. The second round proved more interesting although I think Charlotte Sutcliffe might describe Benny's second round as something more than interesting! He gave spectators the impression that he was more used to the racetrack and was currently practicing to reach the moon, however only 2 fences came down and Charlotte managed to stay with him – not too bad considering he has been away on loan and not jumped at all! Steve Tomkins, our pathfinder, had, I think he would agree, a fairly lucky clear 2<sup>nd</sup> round but this set a good lead for the rest to follow. Lorraine Storer and Luka completed a second stylish clear as did Kay Bugden and Lady Guinevere. Dublin improved his 1<sup>st</sup> round score for Julie Newman by also going clear – I think he gave the bigger jumps a touch more respect! The first fence, a high cross pole with a straight pole through the centre caught a few combinations out who did not approach it straight. Unfortunately Kerry Wilson's Fox Bay was not quite focussed on it either; jumping it off-centre, over one of the high crosses, he took it with him. Such a shame as the rest of the round was immaculate. Karen Duggleby's young Wispa Gold also had a rail down but the distraction caused Karen to turn at the wrong time and she had to circle to get to the next fence. This, combined with allowing Wispa the necessary time to take everything in and not unduly pressurise her meant that they also picked up time faults. Two teams, Meon Black and Solent, finished the 2 rounds on zero penalties and jumped off for 1<sup>st</sup> place and a trip to the Championships, which Meon Black subsequently won. In the meantime, all the remaining results and placings were posted so everyone could be prepared for the prize-giving as soon as the jumping was finished. Bourne Valley A team were part of it, taking a well deserved 4<sup>th</sup> place, decided by the total times for the 2<sup>nd</sup> rounds.

A good day was had by all and the team spirit shown by our team members was great to see. Many thanks to Meon RC for their excellent organisation and to Quob Equestrian Centre for the use of their facilities – the chips and hot chocolates were fantastic!
