BRC Area 17 Novice, Intermediate & Open Horse Trials Qualifier, Sunday 9th July at Knighton Down, Larkhill. (schedule enclosed)

Clubs within Area 17 take turns to organise Area qualifying competitions. Guess what? After running so successfully last year we were asked to repeat the exercise. With the praise and plaudits of our organisational skills ringing in my ears and the success swelling my head, I agreed. All we have to do is pull it off again and show that it wasn't a fluke last time.

This year the task will be more daunting because of the introduction of an Intermediate qualifier, set at a height of 1m, BE Pre-Novice level.

The South Wilts RC are to run Show Jumping phase on the day and other clubs, sending teams, are to man the Cross Country fences, but we are undertaking the overall organisation, the dressage phase, Cross Country control and starting and main scoring. I'm sure it will all be fine on the day.

Although the bulk of the manpower will come from other clubs in the Area and we will not require help on mass, we will want dressage writers & stewards and needless to say we will need help with trailer & caravan towing and setting up. If you are able to help then please call Helen Nash-Steer (towing 01980 847407) or Lindsay Hills (01264 772388).

In addition to the qualifying classes we are able to run classes for everyone at 85cm(2'9"), 1m(3'3") & 1.10m(3'6"). If you don't feel ready or able to take part in the team competition, but still want to have a go then please get your entries in asap. There will be a very limited number of spaces in the classes at each height, so don't leave it until the last opportunity.

Inter Club Team Competitions

Our club is one of twenty designated to British Riding Clubs Area 17. Geographically the area covers the central south of England, stretching from Petersfield in the East to Blandford and Purbeck in the West & includes the Isle of Wight. Our club sits on the northern edge of the area.

Each year inter club team competitions are organised in Show Jumping, Horse Trials and Dressage. The winning teams and individuals from these competitions and from all other Areas around Great Britain go forward to National Riding Club Championships at the end of the summer.

The Horse Trials Championships is held at Offchurch Bury, Nr Leamington Spa between 4th & 6th August. This year a new Intermediate Horse Trials competition, at height 1m, (BE Pre-Novice level) has been added to the list of qualifiers. The Novice & Intermediate Championships becomes a 2 day event, including roads & tracks & steeplechase, and the Open Championships is a full 3 day event. The Championships for all other events will be returning to the Lincolnshire Showground on Saturday 9th September.

Teams comprise four members, with the best three scores accrued to give the team total.

There are two main requirements for members wishing to take part in the above competitions.

The horse must be owned by a BVRC member or a documented long term lease agreement be in existence.

The horse must have valid up to date Flu Vaccination Certificate, which must comply in every respect to the rules shown below.

There are some restrictions in the eligibility of horses and riders for the various competitions. If you wish to be considered for a team place in any of the competitions, please fill in and return the attached team forms to Susie Pool, together with two photocopies of the horse's Flu vacc certificate (one copy for each competition for which you would like to be considered + one extra for Susie).

Please make sure you copy every section (front, back & middle) of the certificate – including the name & address of the owner, the horse's name, silhouette, markings & every single vaccinations entry.

The forms should be returned by **Friday 26th May for all competitions.**

ONCE YOU HAVE RETURNED YOUR FORM PLEASE LET SUSIE KNOW IMMEDIATELY IF YOU ARE NO LONGER AVAILABLE. The team competitions cost the club a lot of money, which we do not want to waste.

The team selection policy is as follows:

On the basis of the response to the team forms, a decision is made about how many teams to enter. Details of how many teams and individuals we want to enter are sent, **with an entry fee**, to British Riding Clubs (in early June).

Anyone applying for team places will be notified by the early/middle of June if their application has been successful.

Entries detailing who is in which team is sent to the Area Competition Organiser (**with another entry fee**) about 7-10 days before the competition is held. The club pays all entry fees to Area competitions.

Selection for team places is based on performance at club competitions or other known events.

It is normally the case that, subject to eligibility, anyone keen to take part will be offered the opportunity to ride for the club.

The area competitions are great events giving us the opportunity to meet and compete against other clubs in the area and participate in a team environment. We want to encourage any one interested to have a go, but in the event of teams or individuals qualifying to go to National Championships, we need to know in advance if you are prepared to go the Championships.

There may be many reasons why you can't or don't want to attend the Championships. It will not stop us asking you to represent the club, but it may just affect who goes in which team.

If you think you would like to have a go but are not sure then ring Susie (01980 671523) for a chat.

Alternatively, Susie & Lindsay will be available to discuss team matters at Ampport Riding Centre on Wednesday 24th May (see 'How to Ride a Dressage test' + BBQ) **from 7pm onwards.**

PLEASE READ ON FOR DETAILS OF THE FLU VACC RULES.

PLEASE READ THE FLU VACC RULES SHOWN BELOW AND MAKE SURE YOUR HORSE'S Certificate COMPLIES WITH THE RULES IN EVERY RESPECT.

Equine Influenza - Valid Certificates – Vaccination procedures

*Each horse must have a valid vaccination certificate, which undeniably relates to that horse, completed, **signed and stamped** on each line by a veterinary surgeon, who is not the owner of the animal. It must state that the horse has two injections for primary vaccination against Equine Influenza given no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days apart. (Only these two injections need to have been given for the horse to compete). In addition a first booster injection must be given no less than 150 days and no more than 215 days after the second injection of the primary vaccination. Subsequently, booster injections must be given at intervals of not more than 1 year apart, commencing after the first booster injection. None of these injections must have been given within the **preceding 7 days**, including the day of the competition or entry into competition stables.*

Horses foaled before 1st January 1980 need not have had the first booster injection (no less 150 days and no more than 215 days) after the second injection of the primary vaccination – but must have had an annual booster (given within 12 months) thereafter.

Note: Where Passports are used as the flu' vaccination record, the horse description must be verified by a vet or authorised member of a breed society.

Special Open Horse Trials, 4th – 6th August 2006

This is an individual, 3 day event competition held in conjunction with the BRC National Novice, Intermediate & Open Horse Trials Championships, at Offchurch Bury, Nr Leamington Spa. Riders and horses must have attained 3 clear rounds at BE Novice level or BRC Open level last year. Horses must have less than 60 BE/IHTS points. There are no qualifiers for this competition. Details on how to enter are available from the British Riding Clubs office (01926 707767)

BRC Area 17 Novice Indoor Show Jumping Qualifier on Sunday 5th March 2006 at Crofton Manor EC

Two teams represented BVRC at the first qualifying competition for 2006. As always, desperate phone calls were made to find last minute replacements for two members who were unable to take part. For once, we were able to start with a full contingent. Entering two teams enables us to give the opportunity for less experienced horses to participate. This was a worthwhile exercise as the novice horses visibly gained confidence in the second round. Seventeen teams took part, some with mixed fortunes. Several riders missed out a fence and were eliminated. Our more experienced team was one of 8 on a zero score on completion of the first round. After a change of track and an increase in height, the second round sorted the men from the boys and only the Wey Valley RC & BVRC remained clear. An exciting, two-way, jump off took place, with one member of each team faulting but each team still remaining on a zero score. Time was to be the decider. After what seemed like forever, the announcement came – we had won by 4 seconds. We were off to the Championships at Hartpury on 22nd April, our first ever visit.

BRC Area 17 Novice Hunter Trial Qualifier – Sunday 2nd April at Tenantry Farm, Rockbourne.

Heavy rain overnight on Friday & Saturday left a huge question mark over whether or not it was going to be possible to run the Hunter Trial qualifier at all. After making some minor course adjustments the competition was allowed to proceed. As with the Indoor Show Jumping we entered 2 Novice teams, giving some inexperienced horses, an invaluable opportunity to compete. In addition we produced an Open team. Our more experienced Novice team didn't get off to a great start. A misunderstanding resulted in a fall for Kay Curley when Guinnie slipped avoiding a jump they thought was on the course. The only good point was, after Kay's experience, none of the others made the same mistake. Good fast clears from Clare and Emma weren't enough to redeem the situation, after the fourth team horse flatly refused to leave the lorry park. Jacquie & Karen also jumped clear, but inexperience meant they jumped around slowly, accruing time penalties. The speed of 450 metres per minute is very fast at this level of competition and difficult to attain. I am sure the team members enjoyed their rides and benefited from the experience.

The Open team had a better day, in spite of a torrential downpour between the classes. With the exception of Charlotte who had severe steering problems, the team jumped clear, each very close to the optimum time. This was an achievement in testing ground and at a speed of 520 metres a minute. So good was their performance that not only did they win the team competition, but were placed first, third and fourth individually. A result that entails a trip to the BRC National Open Hunter Trial Championships at Grange Farm, Peterborough on 14th May. This is very exciting because we haven't ever taken a team to the Championships. We wish them good luck for the day.

We were very excited about going to Hartpury. It is a long time since we qualified a team for Indoor Show Jumping Championships – the last time the competition was held at the National Agricultural Centre, Stoneleigh. The facilities at Hartpury exceeded our expectations with warm up & competition in adjoining indoor schools. Our excitement, however, was short lived. The other two followed, each with a single fence down. Such was the difficulty of the courses that only one team, Charville RC, finished on a zero score and were clear winners. Teams with twelve faults finished in the top ten places. Congratulations to our team members on their excellent performances. Susie & I were very proud to be associated with team members who not only rode beautifully and performed well, but had obviously taken such care in their turnout and appearance.
